During the day we will be attending the Air Raid and Evacuation workshops, where the children will experience how it might have felt for children who lived through World War 2. To be fully immersed and enhance our experience, it would be great if the children could dress up in appropriate clothes for an evacuee, wartime child. It is not expected that you purchase a costume.
