A code is a set of instructions which the computer needs in order for it to complete a task. Every game, app or programme requires a code in order to work.



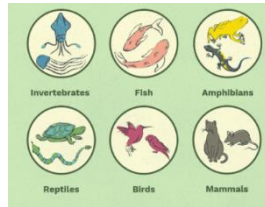

Omnivore – A living thing that eats plants and meat.

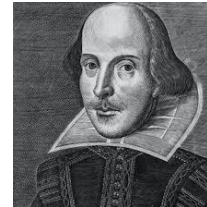
Senses – Sight, hearing, taste, touch, smell.

- William Shakespeare was regarded as one of the greatest writers in English History.
- He was born in Stratford-Upon-Avon in 1564.
- Some of his most famous plays were Romeo and Juliet, Macbeth, Hamlet and a Midsummer Night's Dream.
- He was famous for making fun of important people in many of his plays.
- Shakespeare made up lots of his own language including (1700 words) which we still use today.
- Shakespeare married Anne Hathaway. He was only 18 when he married.
- Many of Shakespeare's plays were performed in The Globe Theatre which was round.
- There were no women in Shakespearean plays or any plays at the time.
